The Clifton Horse Society is sponsoring a CASINO RIDE on the beautiful hilly equestrian trails along the Occoquan River in Fountainhead Regional Park. COME TRY YOUR LUCK!! The games are 5-card draw, roulette, and roll the dice. Come try your luck and see if you can win a prize! There will be a prize for the best adult poker hand, the best junior poker hand, and prizes for winners in roulette and roll the dice games. In 5-card draw you will receive 5 cards at registration. At the first Dealer (Trail Marshall) you come to, you can elect to trade in up to 3 cards; at the second Dealer you come to, you can elect to trade in up to 2 cards; and at the third Dealer you come to, you can elect to trade in up to 1 card. TENSION UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE! (In case of a tie, high card draw will determine winner.) Trails will be well marked as riders "go as they please."

Pre-registration is required because only 30 TRAILER SPACES are available so REGISTER EARLY! Registrations must be received by Tuesday, **October 23, 2007**. After this date, registrations will depend on space available. For late registrations call Mary Flowers at **703-250-6188**.

Directions:

From the Town of Clifton: Take Clifton Road 3 miles south-east to right on Route 610 / Wolf Run Shoals Road. Go 1 mile south to left on Route 643 / Henderson Road. Go ½ mile east to right on Route 647 / Hampton Road. Go 1 mile south and turn right into the entrance to Fountainhead Regional Park. Follow CHS signs to parking on right.

From I-66: Take Exit 55 (Route 7100 / Fairfax County Parkway) south. Go 5 miles south on the parkway and take the Route 123 / Ox Road exit, which loops you under and back up to Route 123. Turn left at the light. Take Route 123 south 3 miles and turn right on Route 643 / Henderson Road. Go 2 miles west on Henderson Road and turn left on Route 647 / Hampton Road. Go 1 mile south on Hampton Road and turn right into the entrance to Fountainhead Regional Park. Follow CHS signs to parking on right.

From the south via I-95: Take Exit 160 (Route 123 / Gordon Blvd) north. Go 4 miles north on Route 123 (which becomes Ox Road after crossing the Occoquan River) and turn left on Route 647 / Hampton Road. Go 3 miles west on Hampton Road and turn left into the entrance to Fountainhead Park. Follow signs to parking on right.

From Manassas: Take the Prince William Parkway 2 miles south of the city limits and turn left on Yates Ford Road. Go 5 miles to the end, turn right on Route 645 / Clifton Road, and follow directions from Clifton. (Note: Yates Ford Road becomes Henderson Road half-way to Clifton Road.)
